all those 1 DEARLY LOVE.


But as I turned and walked away, a tear fell from my eye, for all my life I always thought I didn't want to die.

Donald Eugene Aune, 88, of Stanley, ND went to be with the Lord on October 30, 2020 at which time he was a resident of the Tioga Medical Center Long Term Care in Tioga, ND.

Don was an active member of the First Lutheran Church in White Earth, ND. He was born on June 13, 1932 in Minot, ND, one of 4 sons born to Alfonso and Gunda Aune. He grew up in the Manitou and Lunds Valley area on the family farm and attended school at Lunds Valley and graduated from Stanley High School.
