Phyllis passed away on Saturday, January 1 2022, at the Sidney Health Center, Sidney, MT.

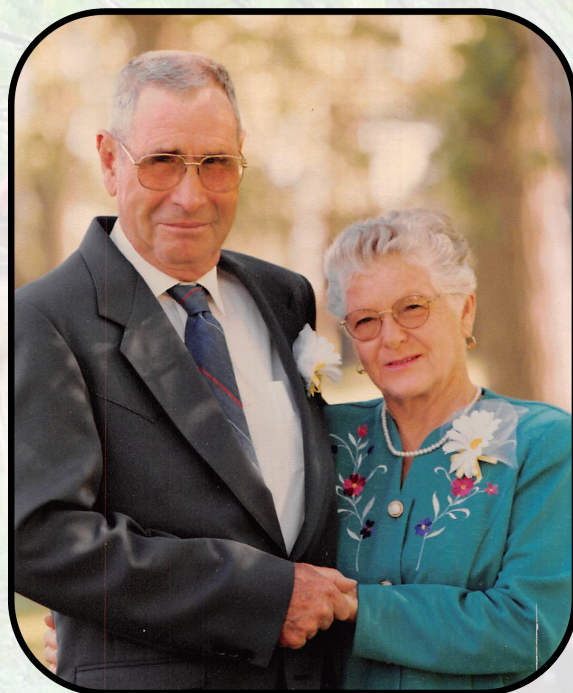
