Kenton decided to complete schooling and receive his GED, which then in turn he decided to join the army.

While serving in the army, he went to Desert Storm, returned from Desert Storm and stayed active in the National Guard until he was honorably discharged. Kenton remained an active supporter of the army with his membership to VFW Post 9061.

Kenton was a simple man. He also was quiet, humble, and kept to himself the majority of the time. Kenton really didn't get involved in sports like his late brother Ben Lovan. He loved traveling and seeing what was out there in the world.
